Ceramics at STEP is designed to help your children learn new skills, have fun, and stretch their imaginations. This year we will be using paper clay, which I have been experimenting with all summer. Paper clay has many advantages for children over conventional clay:

| • It is strong enough to be used for classroom projects without having to be fired. |
| • It can be either fired and glazed, or painted and finished with a white glue and water solution, thus eliminating the the use of spray sealant. |
| • It can be worked dry to dry, so students can carry over projects from week to week. |
| • If pieces fall off (such as snowman's hats, dog tails, and the like), they can be reattached. |
| • It requires less water to work with and generates less mess on the floor and on the student. |

I plan to offer four six-week sessions of Ceramics, with two classes each session. Class I will meet on Tuesdays, 3:30 - 5:00; Class II on Wednesdays, 2:30 - 4:00. The 2010 Calendar will be:
