

# 5<sup>th</sup> Grade Supply List

Welcome to the 5<sup>th</sup> grade! Because space is limited in the classroom, it is important to follow these guidelines for supplies. These quantities are the maximum needed, however some supplies do get used up or run out, so be prepared to replace them. Things such as notebooks and paper will need to be restocked throughout the year, and other things may be requested. Extras may be kept at home until needed at school. Please label all supplies with the student's name, except for those things that will be collected and distributed.

## School Requirement for All Students:

- **Cloth face mask** must be provided by the student. It must be worn at all times on campus and in the classroom.

**\*\*NO breather valve/exhalation valve allowed on the mask.**

**\*\*Masks must meet school guidelines for appropriate wear. No inappropriate, distracting, culturally insensitive graphics, text, logos, or innuendos allowed. The principal may remove a mask if deemed inappropriate and a replacement will be offered.**

- **Personal hand sanitizer is optional (must be UNSCENTED)**

1. 1 box of 24- #2 "Ticonderoga" pencils sharpened\*
2. 1 set of markers (8-12 count, classic colors, fine line/tip) NO Sharpies
3. 1 box colored pencils (8-12 count)
4. 1 pair, pointed scissors
5. 1 pack Pentel Hi-polymer Eraser
6. 5 large glue sticks
7. 1 pack square multi-colored post-its
8. **5** wide ruled composition books (**3- purple**, blue, orange)
9. 1 quad ruled graph notebook for Math
10. 4 plastic/poly-vinyl two-pocket folders (**blue, red, yellow, choice of color**)
11. 1" white binder
12. 2 packs lined college-ruled binder paper
13. 1 ruler, metric and inches
14. 1 container of disinfecting wipes (handy wipes)\*
15. 2 boxes of tissues (large size)\*
16. 3 dry-erase marker \*
17. 1 standard protractor
18. 5 highlighters (in different colors)
19. Pencil case (preferably soft) to bring to Science/lab
